Official Rules, 2024 Caledonia Christmas Electronic Raffle

1. Tickets will be sold online using the electronic lottery system supplied by Rafflebox beginning November 1st, 2024 12:00am and ending on December 15th, 2024 11:59pm.
2. The lottery dates below will occur in the Province of Ontario:
 - a. December 16, 2024, 9:00am (Grand Prize- 1 Draw, 50% of total cash value of tickets sold)
3. Tickets may be purchased for \$10 each, 4 for \$20, 20 for \$50, 100 for \$100. The number of tickets available is unlimited.
4. After purchasing, patrons will be provided a receipt with their registered numbers from a random selection system. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly. The receipt will be sent via e-mail for tickets purchased online, or printed for tickets purchased in-person.
5. The winning ticket number will be selected by a random number generation (RNG) system from all lottery numbers sold.
6. The amount of the grand prize will be determined based on the number and value of tickets purchased (50% of the total cash value).
7. The draw will be made at 151 Caithness Street East, Caledonia, Ontario, N3W 1C2. Canada, and the winning number will be updated in real time on the lottery landing page and on the Caledonia Fair website (www.caledoniafair.ca). The winner will be notified by email or phone number, or in the event that an email address or phone number has not been provided, best efforts will be made to share the winning ticket number through media, social media, and web platforms.
8. Winners may claim their prize by contacting the Caledonia Agricultural Society at (905) 765-6861 or manager@caledoniafair.ca. Winners must have the original receipt containing the winning ticket number and no copies. All payments for cash prizes will be made by cheque.
9. The winning ticket holder has six months to claim their prize from the date of the draw.
10. The winner must provide their name, address, and phone number with photo identification in order to claim their prize.
11. Once the winner is verified and provides photo identification, they will be awarded their prize. If the winner cannot provide photo identification, the prize will be held until such time that photo identification can be provided.
12. In the event that a prize is not claimed, the winning number will be kept on file in a secure location and be held for six-months. After that time period has elapsed, the prize will be donated to the Caledonia Agricultural Society on approval from the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).
13. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the raffle draws:
 - a. Persons whose principal residence is outside of Ontario
 - b. Persons under age 18 years
 - c. Employees the Caledonia Agricultural Society
 - d. Employees of Rafflebox, Inc.
14. The above set of rules will be posted on the lottery website.
